
I am so blessed to have Pamela Wilkins in my live.

I am honored to write this letter on behalf of my sister, Pamela Wilkins, a woman whose life has been defined by faith, responsibility, and love. From my earliest memories, she has been a guiding presence in my life. As the eldest child at home, she assumed responsibilities far beyond her years. While our mother worked long hours, it was my sister who kept watch over five of us three boys. And two girls ensuring that we were safe, cared for, and well supervised. She cooked, guided, and reported on us with the maturity and strength that made her both sister and mother figure.

It is no surprise to me that she grew into a remarkable woman she is today. 


